## INNOVATION CONTINUES WITHOUT FIRST IP GRANT

As you may have already heard, the CT Next Innovation Places Implementation grant application from the Chamber, City and MEDCO was not selected as one of the finalists.



The applications that are in fact moving forward in this highly competitive process are like Apples and Oranges. Apples are the 3 recognized big Hubs with lots of ongoing innovation research and large anchor institutions (Stamford, New Haven and Hartford). Oranges are the other 4 "collaborating communities" that are smaller than the "Apples" and could serve as connectors or satellites…likely never achieving the critical mass status of the Hubs. I am guessing that maybe 2 of the 4 Oranges might likely be funded.

It is important to note that ALL finalists have had some previous innovation/entrepreneurial/place making funding in the past so CTNext does recognize that "seeding" the new communities can become a good thing...but not what this round was intended to do. The reviewers were familiar with beautiful downtown Meriden and recognized our initial need for more place making...which the Chamber, the City and MEDCO are committed to continue to do.

We anticipate that the CTNext staff will visit us in Meriden sometime in June to do a proper and more thorough Leadership Team debriefing. There may be a few creative ways to fund some of the individual pieces and parts from the Meriden application...and perhaps do some "seeding" in Meriden.

It is important to realize how much has already been accomplished during the planning process. We now know the necessary tasks and have fostered great relationships with the over 60 person partnership team. We look forward to continue to work with all of them over the next year...when we submit the next CTNext Innovation Places Grant.



Lary will head up a team of business service professionals to provide customized assistance for employers to expand businesses through hiring, enhance the skills of existing workers and inform decision-making when it comes to employment and training resources in the South Central CT region.

"Experience shows that the best way to help jobseekers is to meet the needs of businesses in our region and in the state," said William Villano, Workforce Alliance's president and CEO. "By creating this unit, we will be more effective in not only offering services but understanding what employers need."

Workforce Alliance is one of five workforce development boards statewide, covering a 30-town area in Middlesex and New Haven counties stretching from Meriden and Middletown down to Greater New Haven, the Route 9 corridor and the eastern shoreline as far as Old Saybrook.

Prior to this, Lary worked directly with jobseekers who had been laid off, and in June will conclude a \$1.5 million project under a grant from the U.S. Department of Labor that helped 150 people get rehired in STEM fields through on-the-job training grants to employers. Previously, she was a human resources professional for American Express and GE Private Equity.

Most of the team will include specialists who have worked on focused projects in the past. Going forward, employers will be able to work with one specialist and have access to the resources of multiple programs, including hiring incentives, worker training and recruitment. Through its regional network of American Job Centers, the business services team will inform career advisors working with job seekers what employers are looking for, and facilitate a good match based on screening, training and job readiness coaching. Annually, more than 15,000 people visit American Job Centers in South Central CT, or participate in targeted programs operated or funded by Workforce Alliance.


