

Rich and I are involved in the walk to fight suicide which will be at the Hamden Town Center Park on Dixwell Avenue, Sunday, September 25th, starting at 11:00 AM to 3:00 PM. It is sponsored by the American Foundation for Suicide Prevention. Suicide is the leading cause of deathbut it is preventable.



We went last year and there were about 900 people walking and it was a truly amazing day. People came with their children and dogs. There were food trucks, music and a 3 mile walk (for those who could and wanted to walk) on the canal culminating with speakers and peoples real life stories.

Everyone knows someone who suffers from depression or someone who has attempted or succeeded in taking their life. It doesn't need to be that way and we need to get the word out that there is help for anyone!!

There is such a stigma about anxiety and depression and too many people are taking their lives without getting on medicine or talking to someone because they don't want to be judged or labeled.
